




Teacher's professional development




Number and rate of dropouts by cause

Number of drop out by cause





National Achievement Test (NAT) - by Mean Percentage Score (MPS)







Stakeholders' Attendance to School Activities, SY 2016-2017





Number of volunteer hours SY 2016-2017




Learner - Teacher ratio


Learner-Classroom ratio
